SYDNEY ST. PATRICK'S DAY (SSPD) ORGANISATION COVID SAFE POLICY

Nothing is more important than the health and safety of all that visits our festival and events. To ensure we keep everyone as safe as is reasonably possible, SSPD Organisation will follow the current COVID Safety guidelines at our events. These guidelines may change based on advice from NSW Health.

QR CODE CHECK-IN

All guests will be required to check in to the main event site using the Service NSW QR Code. Please have the latest version of the Service NSW app downloaded on your phone.

MASKS AND SOCIAL DISTANCING

Masks are mandatory (for those aged 12+) while attending any of our indoor activities and strongly recommended when attending our outdoor event sites. They are also recommended at points where social distancing is not possible such as in queues at bars and toilet areas. If you do not have a mask, we will have some on site to provide you with (subject to availability on the event day). If you have an exemption from wearing a mask, you will be required to present this at entry. Please maintain social distancing where possible.

HAND HYGIENE AND CONTINUOUS CLEANING

Several hand sanitising stations will be made available throughout the event site. Please make sure you use these regularly. Our cleaning crew will be on site throughout the event period to constantly clean washrooms, touchpoints and high traffic areas.
